Where the Money Goes

Almost Home, located in St. Louis, MO, is a loving environment, providing education and support for pregnant and parenting teenagers. Our focus is to help those young women who are making good choices for themselves and their babies by encouraging them to pursue educational goals, job training, and good parenting options.



A United Way Agency, Almost Home's mission is to build new lives for pregnant teens and their babies by providing shelter, food, clothes, education, life skills, therapeutic counseling, mentors, career training and support. Mandatory classes keep the teens focused on their continued education and their responsibilities as parents. It is our mission that we prepare these promising young women for a successful future.

Almost Home has been helping teenage mothers and mothers-to-be, ages 12-19, since 1993.

Facts About Almost Home

- ◆ At Almost Home we value integrity, respect and sensitive caring so that teenage mothers can become responsible parents for their children and productive citizens in the community.
- ◆ Almost Home was founded in 1993 and continues to be sponsored by the Franciscan Sisters of Mary. We serve young women in need from all over the state of Missouri.
- ◆ Almost Home provides long term (two years and more) of transitional housing which includes counseling, educational support and other services to homeless teenage mothers, ages 12 to 19, and their children. We have space for 15 mothers and up to 25 children.
- ◆ The mothers learn basic life skills, including parenting skills, financial management, planning for future independent living, homemaking and job skills.
- ◆ The young women must commit to graduating high school or earning their GED.
- ◆ Counseling, both group and individual, is required.
- ◆ Members are assigned regular household "chores" that reinforce the lessons they learn - Cleaning their rooms and common areas, grocery shopping, helping the cook prepare meals, and personal laundry responsibilities all work to teach independence and life lessons.
- ◆ Most of the mothers that need our help have been victims of crime or abuse - sexual, emotional, physical. Most have suffered from neglect. They have not completed their education and will be un- or under-employed. They have little or no healthy support network.
- ◆ Their children are at risk of being neglected or abused, having ill health, and repeating the cycle of homelessness and poverty. Almost Home seeks to intervene and break that cycle for both mothers and children.
- ◆ The United Way of Greater St. Louis recognized the work being done at Almost Home, and we became a member agency in 2009.
